Government officials do not consult economists, scientists and technologists. The government will have to prepare an army of economists and economic and banking professionals in the country, only then the health of the country's economy will be better.

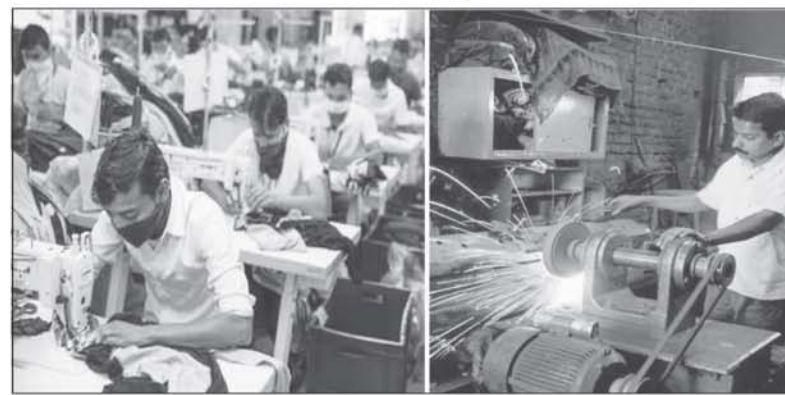
The MSME sector contributes more than one-third of GDP and employs 11 crore people. This sector provides more employment opportunities at lower capital cost. The MSME sector in the country is known for producing more than 6 thousand products. The MSME sector needs to thrive in order to strengthen the economy. There are a large number of MSME enterprises in the country. There are a total of 36 million units in this sector. Of these, 96 percent are proprietary in nature. MSMEs account for 40% of the total workforce of 18 million in the unorganized sector. There are about 6.34 lakh crore non-agricultural unorganized MSMEs in the country. 99 percent of these are micro, 3.3 lakh small and about 5 thousand medium-sized enterprises. Just as the government has brought down the poverty line to alleviate poverty, the same chance in the definition of

increased from Rs 25 lakh to Rs 1 crore and the turnover limit to Rs 5 crore, investment limit for small enterprises to Rs 10 crore and turnover to Rs 50 crore, investment limit for medium enterprises 50 crores and turnover limit has been increased to 250 crores.

The Modi government has tried to revive the MSME sector through the "Self-reliant India Package". The government has announced a loan of Rs 3 lakh crore without guarantee to the enterprises of MSME sector. Apart from this, the government has announced a guarantee cover of Rs 20 thousand crore to provide additional loans to MSMEs who are under great pressure and whose loan accounts are NPAs in the bank. But only big companies will benefit from it, micro and small units will not be able to take advantage of it because they are in the unorganized sector. The government has not yet understood the real problem of this sector. There are problems of lack of working capital, demonetisation, Goods and Services Tax, domestic and global competition, non-payment on time, etc. in this sector. The government departments of the central and state governments are reluctant to pay these small enterprises. Government departments owe more than Rs 11 thousand crore to micro and small industries.

The domestic industries needed the protection of the government. There has been a lack of foresight in the policies of the government. Small and medium-scale businesses needed a dose of incentive and relief from the government that they should have got, but the government's helpless attitude towards them could not make the small and medium scale industries progress despite their capabilities. The government's policies (foreign trade policy, import-export policy, industrial policy, taxation policy, debt waiver, subsidy reduction etc.) have killed the cottage industries and small scale industries in the country. The cost of business in our country is high according to the corporate world and SME sector. The government will have to do a deep analysis of the cost and reach the roots of this problem and remove those obstacles only then the business environment will be created in the country.

For this, the central government and the state governments



will have to work together.

A panel is being formed to approve the proposal of new industries in 3 months to attract foreign investment in MSMEs. A Joint Secretary level officer has been appointed in this panel. NITI Aayog is working on a plan to connect small and medium enterprises (SMEs) to e-commerce platforms and to create an online repository of Indian SMEs' products. Cottage industries, handloom industries and small industries need more incentives. The turnover limit of exemption from audit to small retailers, businesses, shopkeepers of MSME sector has been increased from Rs 1 crore to Rs 5 crore. There will be an app based invoice to prevent delayed payment to MSMEs. Now according to Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the face of industrialization will also change. According to him, now the government will also promote agro-based industries. The government is working on an MSME policy focused on the agricultural sector. Agro based industries will start on the lines of start ups, which will provide employment to the villagers in the village itself and their migration to the cities will also be stopped. The Prime Minister announced an economic package of Rs 20 lakh 97 thousand 532 crore on May 12, 2020 to repair the supply chain and make the country self-reliant. The government should bring the Covid-19 Savings Letter Scheme to raise funds. By the way, there is a good news for the country's economy that during the lockdown there has been a huge increase in the foreign exchange

reserves of the country. Crude oil prices have fallen sharply, in which the government has saved a lot of foreign exchange and is helping to meet the financial deficit. The benefit of this savings should be given to industries and consumers in the form of a reduction in GST rates, which will increase demand.

Micro, small and medium scale industries need financial, regulatory and government support. Right now banks are lagging behind in lending to small, small scale industries and NBFCs due to increasing NPAs.

The government is giving 100 percent guarantee for bank loans to these industries. Some MSMEs take loans from NBFCs and bank loans to these NBFCs.

The agro-based industry in the country is negligible in rural areas. The government will first have to set up agro-based industries in which the farmers can consume crops such as flour mills, oil mills, rice mills, cotton mills and small cottage industries such as tomato sauce, keeping in mind the local crop in rural areas. Jams, papads, candles, incense sticks, chips, siwaiyans, pickles and marmalades, etc., will also provide employment to local rural youth in these industries. On the one hand, farmers will also get fair price for their crops
