

Special Ministerial Consultations and Recommendations on Global Biofuels Alliance

Energy Transitions Ministerial Meeting has highlighted Fuels for Future (FF) as one of the priority areas. In this context, on the sidelines of the Energy Transitions Ministerial Meeting a standalone event on Consultations and Recommendations for the Global Biofuels Alliance was organized on 22nd July 2023 in Goa. This event received strong support from countries within and beyond the G20. Nineteen countries expressed their interest in being the initiating members of the alliance with fifteen countries and nine international Organizations attending the event. This signifies a momentous step forward in advancing the development and deployment of biofuels through a multi-stakeholder global alliance. This GBA event witnessed participation from the Energy Ministers of thirteen countries and Heads of nine international organizations. India, Argentina, Bangladesh, Brazil, Canada, Italy, Kenya, Mauritius, Paraguay, Seychelles, the United States, UAE and Uganda, and international organisations such as the Biofuture Platform, International Civil Aviation Organisation, International Energy Agency, International Energy Forum, International Renewable Energy Agency, World Bank, World Biogas Association, and World Economic Forum who were part of the event welcomed the initiative. Emphasizing the importance of biofuels and collaboration, the Union Minister for Petroleum and Natural Gas & Urban and Housing Affairs, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, said "True success of Global Biofuels Alliance will depend on moving this project from a project to the government to the project to the people." Ministers from several other countries also highlighted the appeal of biofuels as a low-carbon pathway, while underscoring the critical necessity for engaging in clean energy initiatives. The leaders highlighted that despite the huge potential of Biofuels as an important low-carbon pathway to development, several challenges continue to hinder their adoption. Jennifer Granholm, Secretary of Energy US, remarked that the United States recognize the establishment of a Global Biofuels Alliance as a critical step in their biofuels journey and that they look forward to

moving from "test tube to test drive and field to fuels". Mr. Alexandre Silveira de Oliveira, Minister of State of Mines and Energy, Brazil, highlighted that to meet sustainable energy needs multiple forms of energy will be required and, in this context, reinforced the importance of the alliance. Multiple countries including Brazil, Italy, Kenya, and UAE highlighted the importance of sharing best practices across policy, technology, and implementation.

The forum recognized that overcoming challenges such as feedstock management, standardization, and technological innovations requires a collaborative approach and welcomed the initiative by Indian Presidency to create the global alliance. Further, International Organizations such as IEA and IEF reinforced the importance and potential of biofuels for other countries and highlighted the importance of standardization, waste recycling, and investments to build on the untapped potential. ICAO emphasized that more than 600 Billion liters of SAF are required to replace all fossil fuels, translating into more than USD 3 trillion in investment by 2050. This necessitates the need for close collaboration across stakeholders.

These centres would be different from the one in Rajasthan. There is now a ray of hope for the conservation of the Great Indian Bustard (GIB). Union minister for forest and environment, Bhupendra Yadav, has asked the Gujarat, Maharashtra and Karnataka governments to send a proposal to set up breeding centres for conservation of GIBs in their respective states. During the meeting of the standing committee of the National Board for Wildlife (NBWL), the minister proposed to establish breeding centres, and has directed the Wildlife Institute of India (WII) to prepare a framework for the same.

The Gujarat and Rajasthan governments had in the past locked horns over a male GIB, but the latter had refused to send the male species to Gujarat. The last male from the GIB sanctuary in Kutch has been missing since December 2018. Senior officials from the ministry of environment forest and climate change said, "Gujarat had already made up its mind to have its own breeding centre but unfortunately the only surviving male went missing and has not returned till date. The ministry will give a male GIB to Gujarat, but the state will have to promise to lay the high tension cables underground."

Only then would they be permitted to release the birds into the wild. According to a 2018 count, India has fewer than 150 GIBs, of which 122 are in Rajasthan. Gujarat has just four females left. "Gujarat should preserve the GIB landscape of Kutch and start mitigating the problem of overhead power lines as directed by the Supreme Court," said an expert on bustards. Gujarat must launch

efforts to manage the habitat in such a way that captive-bred birds can be released here in the future, he said. An expert on GIBs said that Gujarat has not done enough for conservation though the bird was the mascot of the 13th Conference of the Parties (COP) of the UN Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals, held in Gandhinagar in 2020. However, in April 2022, an affidavit filed by Dipesh Raj, an undersecretary of the Gujarat government's energy department, said: "...there are four female GIBs left in the Kutch area, and therefore the option of relocating the GIBs may be explored."

In 2017, the state, in collaboration with the Wildlife Institute of India (WII) and expertise offered by the United Arab Emirates (UAE), had planned to set up a breeding centre for Great Indian Bustard (GIB) at Naliya in Kutch. The Union minister for forest and environment, Bhupendra Yadav, has asked Gujarat, Maharashtra and Karnataka governments to send a proposal to set up breeding centres for conservation of GIBs in their respective states, reports Himanshu Kaushik. During the meeting of the standing committee of the National Board for Wildlife (NBWL), the minister proposed to establish breeding centres, and has directed the Wildlife Institute of India (WII) to prepare a framework for the same. These centres would be different from the one in Rajasthan. There is now a ray of hope for the conservation of the Great Indian Bustard (GIB).
