This event received strong support from countries within and beyond the G20. strong support from countries within and beyond the G20. Nineteen countries expressed their interest in being the initiating members of the initiating of the initiation of Energy Agency, World Bank, World Biogas Association, and Energy Agency, World Bank, World Biogas Association, and World Economic Forum who were part of the event welcomed the initiative. Emphasizing the importance of biofuels and collaboration, Union Minister for Petroleum and Natural Gas & Urban and Housing Affairs, Shir Hardeep Singh Puri, said "True success of Global Biofuels Alliance will depend on moving this project from a project of the government to the project of the people." Ministers from several other countries also highlighted the appeal of biofuels as a low-carbon pathway, while underscoring the critical necessity for engaging in clean energy initiatives. The leaders highlighted that despite the huge potential of Biofuels as an important low-carbon pathway to development.

Alexandre Silveira de Oliveira, Minister of State of Mines and Feat was flexing to flower and the state of State of Mines and Energy, Brazil, highlighted that to meet sustainable energy needs multiple forms of energy will be required and, in this context, reinforced the importance of the alliance. Multiple countries including Brazil, Italy, Kenya, and UAE highlighted the importance of sharing best practices across policy, technology, and implementation.

The forum recognized that overcoming challenges such as feedstock management, standards development, and technological innovations requires a collaborative approach and welcomed the initiative by Indian Presidency to create the global alliance. Further, International Organizations such as IEA and LEF reinforced the expansive potential of biofuels for other countries and highlighted the importance of standardization, waster recycling, and investments to build on the untapped potential. ICAO emphasized that more than OD Billion liters of SAF are required to replace all fossil fuels, translating into more than USD 3 trillion in investments by 2050. This necessitates the need for close collaboration across stakeholders.

An expert on GIBs said that Gujarat has not done enough for conservation though the bird was the mascot of the 13th Conference of the Parties (COP) of the UN Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals, held in Gandhinagar in 2020. However, in April 2022, an affidavit filed by Dipesh Raj, an undersecretary of the Gujarat government's energy department, said: "where are four female GIBs left in the Kutch area, and therefore the option of relocating the GIBs may be explored." In 2017, the state, in collaboration with the Wildlife Institute of during the meeting it was also instructed that wherever there is need for a male GIB, it must be given the same. The breeding centre in Rajasthan has about 28-odd birds, and one male can easily be moved to Gujarat. The state does not want to lose the opportunity and will soon propose the centre in Gujarat. A project was readled by the government in 2017. Nityanand Srivastava, in charge principal chief conservator of forest (wildlife), said, "We will soon send the proposal to set up a breeding centre in the GIB sanctuary in Kutch. Once approved, the state already has a notified sanctuary."

The Gujarat and Rajasthan government badin the past locked horns over a male GIB, but the latter had refused to send the male species to Gujarat. The lating in Kutch has been missing since December 2018. Senior officials from the milistry of environment forest and idmate change said, "Gujarat had already made up its mild to have its own breeding centre but unfortunately the only surviving male went missing and has not returned till date. The millistry will give a male GIB to Gujarat, but the state will have to promise to lay the nightension cables underground.
